

Conditions for Photographic Reproductions from Whakatāne Museum and Arts

- 1. Reproductions of collection items are provided under this agreement for the **specified use** only.
- 2. A separate application must be made for permission to publish the same reproductions in additional publications or reprints.
- 3. Copyright for reproductions provided by the Whakatāne Museum and Arts for publication remains the property of the copyright holder and is not transferred or reassigned to the author or publisher for whom the image is provided.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that permission to publish material is obtained from the copyright holder.
- 5. Reproductions cannot be sold or in any way further reproduced without prior written consent of the Museum and payment of an additional reproduction fee.
- 6. The Whakatāne Museum and Arts cannot reproduce material that could be damaged in the reproduction process. Neither can the museum reproduce any collection item from a closed or restricted collection.
- 7. All applicable reproduction, publication and administrative fees will be paid by the applicant for each publication request. A schedule of fees is available from on Whakatāne Museum and Arts website.
- 8. Acknowledgement will be made to Whakatāne Museum and Arts or another specified source. The acknowledgement must be placed as close as possible to the published reproduction.
